Black Park Shed Management of Health & Safety Policy Statement

The priority for **Black Park Shed** is to provide or ensure the provision of safe and healthy conditions for its leisure and other activities including incorporated equipment and systems of working for all of the members. Further, to provide any relevant information, training, supervision and instruction required for this purpose.

Black Park Shed acknowledges its responsibilities to 3rd parties influenced by its operations and actions.

The Health and Safety Policy Statement will be regularly reviewed to ensure its pertinence in regard to the manner in which **Black Park Shed** develops and changes. This review is to be carried out at least annually but particularly with regard to the influence any events that would benefit the plan by earlier inclusion.

The main provisions are therefore:

- a) To encourage communication and consultation in order to promote efficient development of systems and working practices in a manner which targets the elimination of risk to members health and safety and to implement enduring environmental awareness and protection systems.
- b) To gain the acknowledgement from all members that their cooperation is imperative and meaningful in creating an environment where injury or ill health can be prevented.
- c) To develop procedures for the reporting, recording and investigation of all near miss and/or dangerous occurrences so that preventative measures can be evolved.
- d) To conduct regular checks of systems and procedures to identify and eliminate unsafe acts and conditions and implement control measures in all areas where the work is being undertaken thus preventing any injury, ill health and loss or damage to property or the environment.
- e) To implement and maintain high standards of safety and health for all members and for the protection of the environment by ensuring that all safety practices and procedures conform to current legislation.
- f) To inform members of their responsibilities and duties to take all reasonable care of their own safety and that of their colleagues who may be affected by their acts and/or omissions.
- g) To ensure that best efforts are made so that all tasks are well planned, controlled, organised and monitored throughout there duration.
